## Workshop Format

About 330 Academy members take part in some 40 workshops. Each workshop has approximately 20 participants, led by one or more facilitators drawn from the membership. Guided by the facilitators, members shape the course and take their turn presenting their chosen topic to the group - then everyone takes part in the discussions! Most workshops convene for two hours every two weeks, meeting for a total of twelve sessions between September and April.

## Fees and Membership

The membership price for 2015-16 is just \$175. For the one fee, members can enroll in up to four workshops, and are also encouraged to participate in a variety of special events sponsored by the Academy during the year. These events include **Forums** in the fall and winter, and **Spring Talks** - a series of six guest speakers - in April and May. In addition, there are informal walks, seasonal luncheons and picnics - all designed to offer members additional opportunities to share ideas and enjoy each other's company.
