We have all been the grateful recipients of the skillful and vivid images created by artistic illustrators. Their works have frequently been mass produced and so have reached an extensive audience for their artistry.

Many talented and now well-known visual artists entered the business of illustration to pay their rent or put food on the table. During or after their time as illustrators, these artists also engaged in their fine art activities. Other visual artists pursued the art of illustration as an end in itself and you may not have heard their names previously.

Nonetheless, each artistic illustrator accepted commissions from book and magazine editors, advertising agencies or companies, as well as other sources that required superb illustrations of their stories, or promotion of their products.

Our **Fall Term Only** workshop will have twelve presentation slots, and members may wish to present one or more of the artistic illustrators listed below. We will also consider other illustrators who group members may wish to present.

We will discuss a variety of time periods, art styles and techniques in which these illustrations were created. It is hoped that members will present digital talks with many illustrations that exemplify the illustrator’s unique talent and explain the specific information the illustrations were intended to convey. As is the custom in the Academy, after registration participants who “reserve” their presentation topics first will be given priority.
